1. Empowering India-2025 Exhibition (12th to 14th September 2025 at Panjim Convention Centre, Goa)

The **Empowering India-2025 Exhibition** was a major national event held from **12–14 September 2025 at Panjim Convention Centre, Goa**. 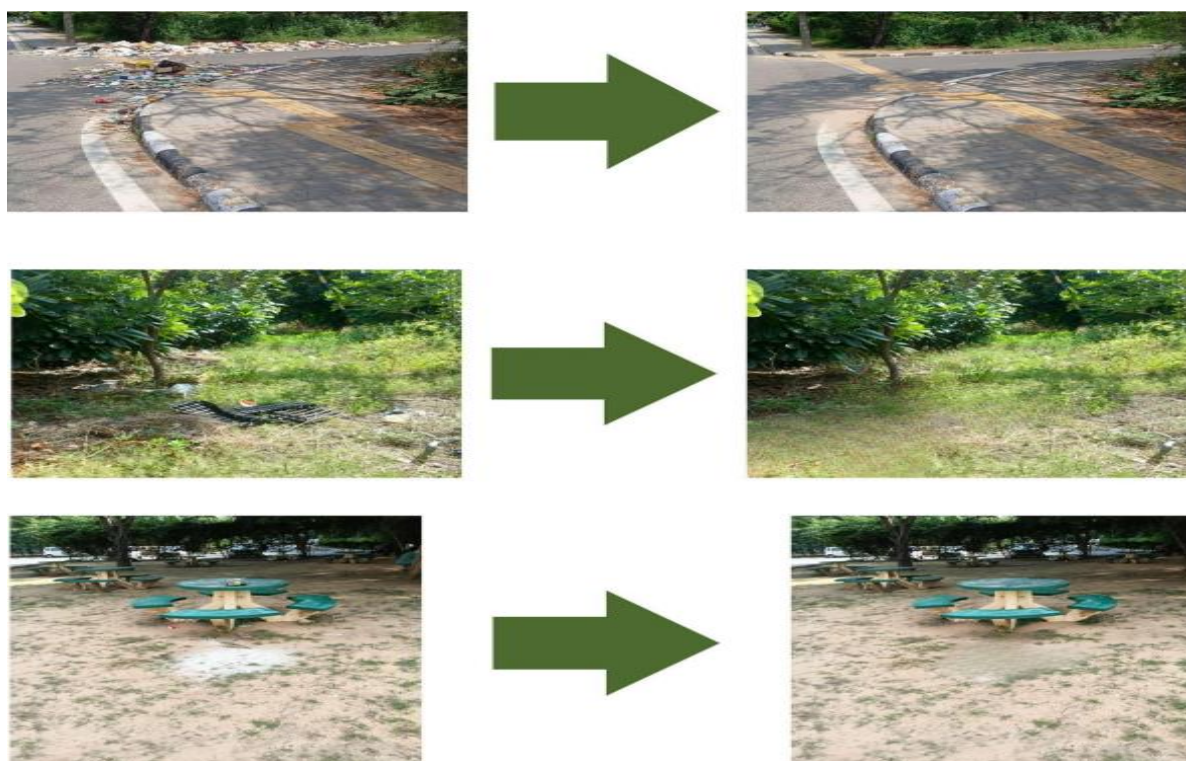
C. Express Yourself (NSS) – 30th September 2025

5. Pride of Nation Awards 2025 on 16th December 2025

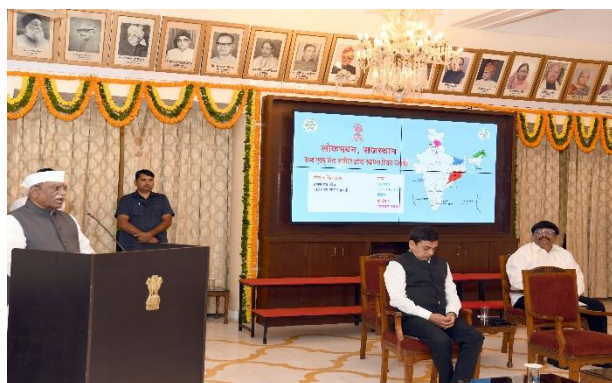
