MINUTES OF 36th MEETING OF SENATE HELD ON 24th MARCH 2017

The 36th meeting of Senate was held on 24th March 2017 at 4.00 PM in Conference Hall, Director Secretariat, Prabha Bhawan of the Institute.

The details of the members who could not attend the meeting due to their pre-occupations are given in **Annexure-A** (enclosed).

At the outset, the Dean, Academic Affairs welcomed the Director & Chairman Senate and Senate members. The Chairman Senate in his remarks in his first Senate meeting of MNIT Jaipur welcomed all the members present in the meeting. Director & Chairman Senate and Senate members also appreciated the contribution of the former Director Prof. I. K. Bhat and Prof. A. B. Gupta-I/C Director, MNIT Jaipur for remarkable development in various fields of the Institute during their tenure.

The agenda items were taken one by one, the resolutions of which are as follows:

Item No. 36.1.0	:	To confirm the minutes of the 35th meeting of the Senate held on 06th October 2016. The minutes of the 35 th meeting of Senate were Confirmed.
Item No. 36.2.0	:	To note the "Action Taken" on the decisions taken in the 35th meeting of the Senate. The "Action Taken Report" on the 35 th meeting of the Senate was noted.
Item No. 36-3-0	:	Items for consideration.
Item No. 36-3.1	:	To consider the matter regarding payment of fellowship to research scholars in non-science subjects at the UGC rates subject to fulfilling the UGC-NET qualifications by them. Currently the financial assistantship to Ph.D students in the institute is offered under the following three categories: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Research assistantships from the sponsored research projects.2. Additional assistantship in the form of scholarships, fellowships etc. may be available through organizations such as Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), University Grant Commission (UGC)/Department of Atomic Energy (DAE)/DST/MHRD/Corporate Houses etc.3. Institute assistantship as per the approved rates notified by MHRD from time to time. Institute assistantship in Basic Sciences and Professional courses is being provided as

	<p>per the MHRD letter (F. No. 17-2/2014-TS.I dated March 02, 2015) and DST's office memorandum No.SR/S9/Z-09/2012 dated 21-10-2014.</p> <p>MHRD vide its letter No. F. No. 33-4/2016-TS-III, dated-1st December, 2016 on the subject "Payment of Fellowship to research scholars in the non-science subjects" conveyed the approval for payment of fellowship to research scholars in non-science subjects in the NITs and IEST, Shibpur at the UGC rates subject to fulfilling the UGC-NET qualifications by them".</p> <p><i>The matter regarding eligibility for grant of Institute Fellowship/scholarship to the Ph.D students registered in the Department of Management Studies and Department of Humanities and Social Sciences was discussed. It was decided that Chairman Senate would constitute a Committee to submit a report in this matter.</i></p>
Item No. 36-3.2	<p>: To consider the letter received from MHRD regarding review of vacant seats for UG programme for the last three years admitted through JOSAA.</p> <p>As per letter No. 35-1/2014-TS.III, Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Dept. of Higher Education, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi, dated 17th February 2017 to minimize the vacancies in Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) participating in the Joint Councelling Process.</p> <p><i>The Senate reviewed the vacant seats for the last three years. After proper review of seat vacancies, employment opportunities, national requirements, available infrastructure/faculty and scope for future, the senate decided that present programs intake may be kept for admission in all UG programme run by the Institute.</i></p>
Item No. 36-3.3	<p>: To consider the matter regarding change in the name of M.Sc. degree in the departments of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics.</p> <p>In pursuance of the direction of SPGB, DFBs of all three Sciences department have sent the recommendations of all the three M.Sc. programmes, regarding change of the name of the PG courses i.e. M. Sc. Chemistry from Applied Chemistry, M.Sc. Physics from Applied Physics and M.Sc. Mathematics from Applied Mathematics, after extensive discussion it was recommended that the name of M.Sc. degree programme be changed.</p> <p><i>After detailed discussion the Senate approved the name of all three M.Sc. courses namely M.Sc. Physics, M.Sc. Chemistry and M.Sc. Mathematics. These amendments may come into force for students of M.Sc. degree program admitted in the session 2016-17 and onwards for all three M. Sc. courses.</i></p>
Item No. 36-3.4	<p>: To consider the matter regarding revision in Maternity Leave Rules for the Ph.D. students registered in this Institute.</p> <p>It has been noticed that there is no uniformity regarding maternity leave rules for Ph.D. students in various Technical Institutions.</p> <p>The matter regarding the revision in the duration of maternity leave admissible to the Ph.D. students registered in the institute. In light of letter No. F.No.17-2/2014-TS.I dated 18-02-2015 of Government of India, MHRD, Dept. of Higher Education, Technical Section-I under 3.3 states the following "Leave and other entitlement benefits: Maternity Leave as per Government of India instructions issued from time to time would be available to female candidates in all categories.</p>

	<p><i>The Senate deliberated the matter and decided that Maternity/paternity leave to Ph.D. scholars may be granted at par with maternity/paternity leave for MNIT employees. Maternity/paternity leave shall be granted only once in a programme.</i></p>
Item No. 36-3.5	<p>To consider the list of students of M. Tech./M.Plan./MBA for termination from Institute rolls due to poor performance/non registration etc. upto Even Semester 2016-17.</p> <p>As per the guidelines stipulated in the PG regulation for promotion to the next semester of the M. Tech/M.Plan./MBA programs, a student is required to obtain a minimum CPGA of 5.5 in each semester, non registered etc upto even semester 2016-17. On the recommendation of SPGB, the list of such students who have failed to attain the required CGPA, non registered etc upto even semester during even semester academic year 2016-17 and have been terminated from their respective program.</p> <p><i>The Senate deliberated and decided to terminate the students from the Institute rolls who have failed to attain the required minimum CPGA (list enclosed at Annexure-B) and non registered etc upto even semester 2016-17(list enclosed at Annexure-C).</i></p>
Item No. 36-3.6	<p>To consider the list of students of Ph.D. for termination from Institute rolls due to poor performance/non registration etc. upto Even Semester 2016-17.</p> <p>As per the guidelines stipulated in the PG regulation for promotion to the next semester of the Ph.D. programs, a student is required to obtain a minimum CPGA of 7.00 in each semester/non registered etc more than 1.5 years upto even semester 2016-17. On the recommendation of the SPGB, the list of such students who have failed to attain the required CGPA/non registered etc upto even semester 2016-17 and have been terminated from their respective program.</p> <p><i>The Senate discussed and decided to terminate the students from the Institute rolls (list enclosed at Annexure-D).</i></p>
Item No. 36-3.7	<p>To consider the issue regarding open electives for Ph.D. in Humanities & Social Sciences.</p> <p>The department has proposed for waiver of the limit of minimum strength of 15 students to run the PG open electives floated by HSS opted by the Ph.D. scholars, permission to float program electives specific to Ph.D. without the constraint of the prescribed strength and develop Blended MOOCS courses for its Ph.D. programme.</p> <p>The matter was discussed in the 36th meeting of SPGB held on 28th February 2017 vide Item No. 32-2.4. The SPGB rejected the proposal and suggested that open elective courses be offered to both UG and PG students. For program electives specific to Ph.D. students, the department can explore the possibility of signing a MoU with the Central University of Rajasthan, Kishangarh and the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.</p> <p>The matter was discussed at length, it was felt that the decision of SPGB would seriously affect the current students registered in the department of humanities as they would not have sufficient electives to complete the requirements of the coursework credits. Senators also expressed their concern over PhD students taking up course work which is not related to their general area of research. In these cases the course work was merely being taken to complete credit requirements rather than adding to the</p>

knowledge in PhD domain area. It was suggested to include MOOCs in its blended form from reputed Platforms and Universities to address the issue as large number of such courses was available. Senators also expressed concern that courses being run for one or two students would reflect a non serious approach to the course work. It was also felt that Undergraduate and Masters courses should be run as standard courses and should not be offered merely to address the requirement of coursework of PhD students.

Having class size of less than 15/7 for course work of Ph.D (where teaching load is not counted as load for faculty), introducing blended MOOCs etc. for PhD students for from session 2017-18 was agreed in Principle. The guidelines regarding Ph.D. course work shall be proposed by Academic Section and implemented after approval of the Chairman Senate. The scheme would be tried for one semester and reviewed after the Odd Semester 2017-18.

Item No. 36-3.8 : **To consider the proposal of National Technical Research Organization (NTRO), New Delhi for one or two seats in M. Tech. and Ph.D. courses (part time/full time) for NTRO officers as sponsored candidates.**

As per letter No. XIV/04/DO/2016-679, Government of India, National Technical Research Organization, Block-III, Old JNU Campus, New Delhi-110067, dated 20th October 2016 for consideration of NTRO Officials as Sponsored Candidates for higher education i.e. one or two seats in M. Tech. and Ph.D. courses (part time/full time) may be considered for NTRO officers as sponsored candidates.

The Senate approved the proposal of NTRO for one or two seats in M. Tech. and Ph.D. courses (part time/full time) as Sponsored candidate of NTRO Officials. The seat would be supernumery across all disciplines and MoU with NITRO be signed to facilitate the same.

Item No. 36-3.9 : **To consider the eligibility criteria for admission in M. Tech. programme in the Department of Chemical Engineering.**

DPGC of Chemical Engineering Department recommended to divide seats of PG program 'M.Tech. in Chemical Engineering' in two groups (seat allocation 50-50% for each group) with qualification as following:
